### Buyer Registration

### Guide Prices

Guide prices are in no way definitive and they only exist to help buyers gauge likely values. Where items are offered for sale subject to a reserve price, it is our policy to reflect the reserve price at a level no higher than the lower end of the "guide price".

### VAT

Lots marked with an asterisk ( \* ) will be sold at the hammer price plus VAT, in addition to the Buyers premium.

### Buyers' Premium

All lots purchased are subject to a Buyers' premium at 15% (plus VAT at the standard rate). In addition, purchases online will be subject to an additional surcharge as will items purchased with a credit card.

### Electrical Goods

Electrical items are tested to comply with DTI standard for safety. This in no way implies that the item is in working order.
