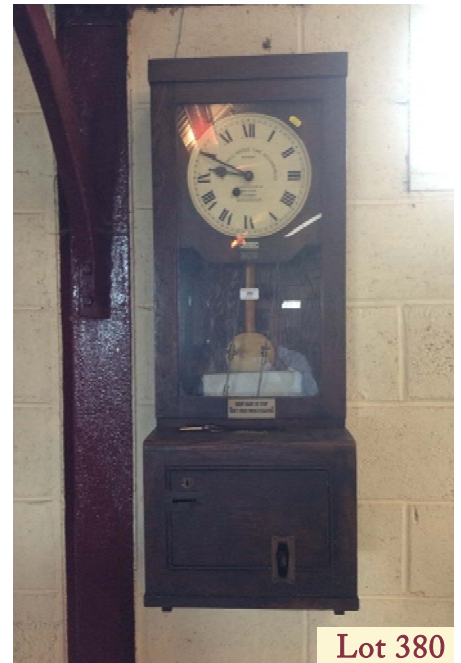

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INTRODUCTION The following defining terms are used in these conditions:-
